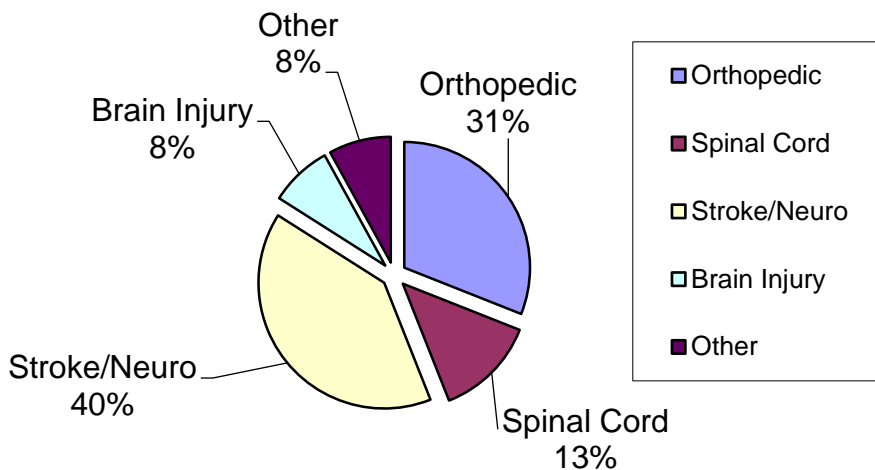


# St. Joseph Hospital Acute Inpatient Rehab Report Card 2019

The St. Joseph Rehabilitation Center in Eureka, California has been serving the community since 1987. This summary has been prepared in an effort to inform potential patients, families, medical personnel and other interested parties about the types of patients who benefit from rehab, their average length of stay, and how effectively and efficiently services are delivered.

Although our patients have many diagnoses and come from all walks of life, our typical patient is 70 years old and is a stroke survivor, or recuperating from an orthopedic surgery, spinal cord injury, or other significant medical issue.

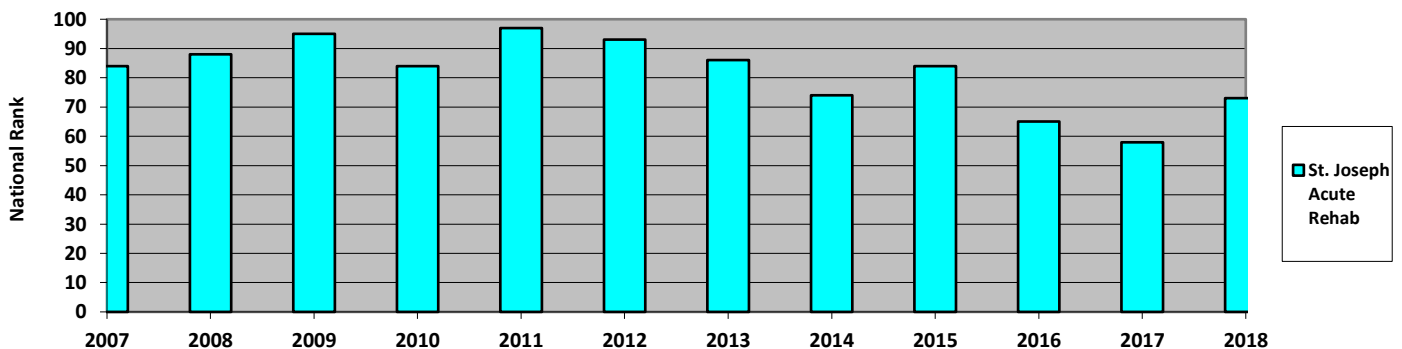

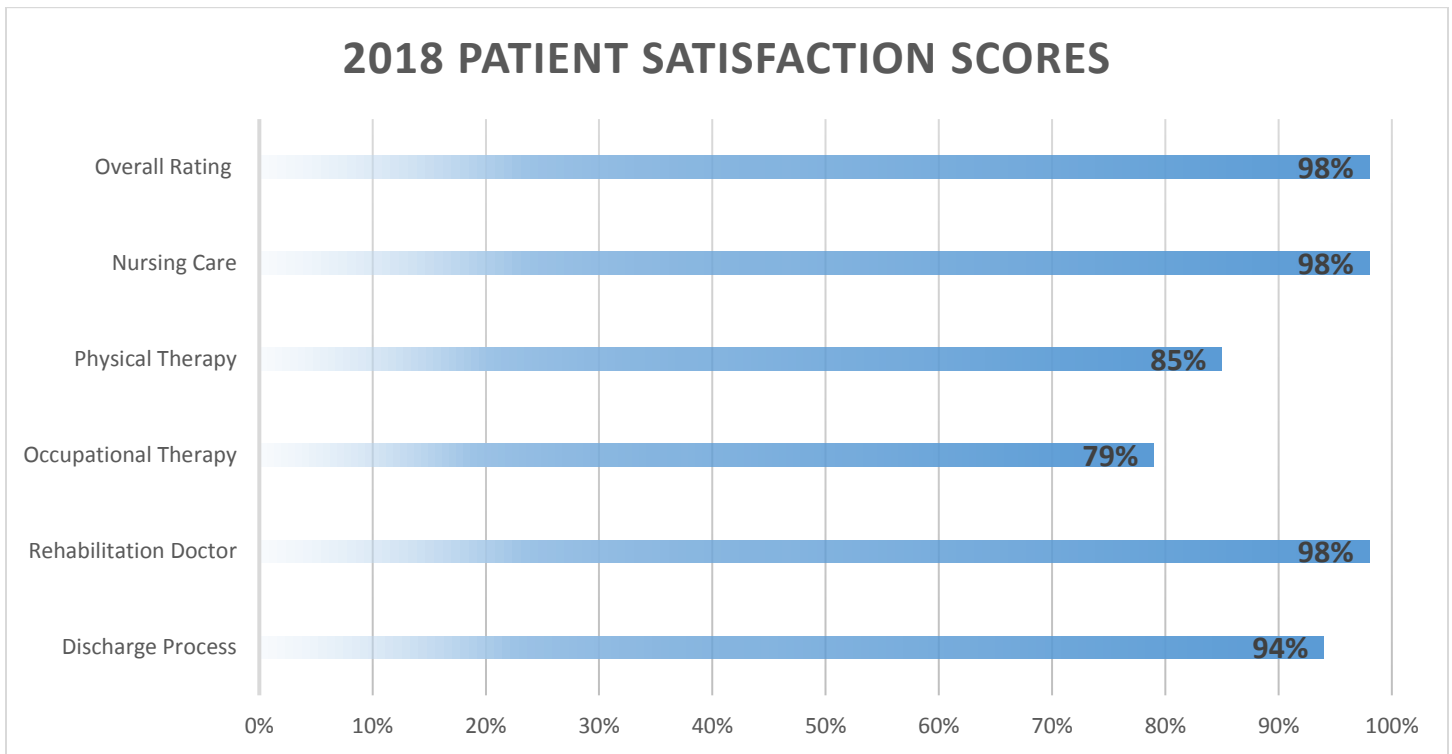
## Recipient of Top Performer Award

St. Joseph's Acute Rehab Unit has been recognized as a Top Performer since comparisons began in 2007. Out of over 800 Acute Rehabilitation Units, St. Joseph consistently ranks in the top percentile in the Nation for patient outcomes. This designation is based on performance metrics which include complexity of disability and diagnosis, length of stay and discharge destination.



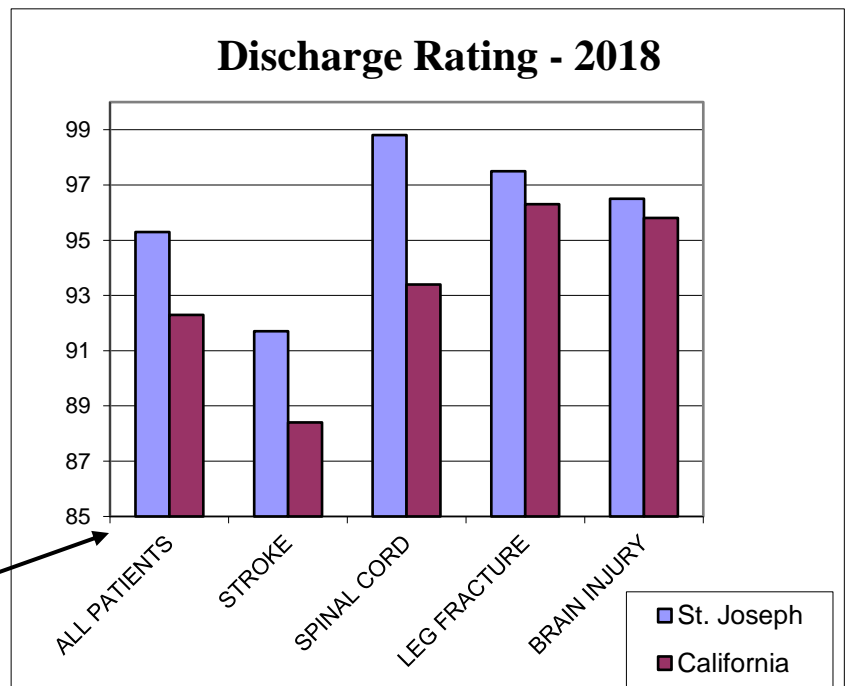

## Excellent Care + Patient Improvement

All rehab patients are assessed using a Functional Independence Measure (FIM) scoring system to measure their mobility and ability to care for themselves. Assessments are done at admission and discharge, and progress is tracked throughout their stay. These scores, combined with length of hospitalization, discharge-to-home percentage, and medical complexity comprises the hospital's Discharge Rating.
